Background:

Health Education England North West Team (HEE NW) presents a health and wellbeing workshop for the health and care workforce here in the North West.

The workshop will provide a forum for clinical leaders in health, social care, local authority settings and educators to come together to consider a collaborative approach to enabling the health and care workforce to contribute fully to preventive healthcare in daily practice.

Taking a new network and distributed leadership approach we invite colleagues to come together to shape a future multi professional prevention network – with a particular focus on self-care and preventive healthcare.

Workshop feedback will inform the development and planning of this network to support and enable the prevention role of the health and care workforce across the North West. The network will also enable “self-care” across the health economy through the NHS and wider social care workforce.
