In 2015 a wide-ranging group of multidisciplinary public health staff and members of the wider workforce, from across the UK came together to help shape and contribute to the development of a UK wide Public Health Skills and Knowledge Framework. The agreed framework has now been published, along with a guide on how it can be used by individuals and employers who deliver on public health outcomes.
